Professor Markus Schlaich

Professor Schlaich is a renal physician and an ESH accredited hypertension specialist with a strong background in clinical research. His main scientific interests focus on pathophysiologic aspects of hypertension including the contribution of the sympathetic nervous system, the L-arginine/nitric oxide pathway, their interaction, and the involvement of the kidneys. Professor Schlaich has a specific interest in treatment modalities targeting the sympathetic nervous system and has contributed to the development of renal denervation as a novel therapeutic approach to hypertension.

He has been highly successful in attracting competitive grant funding including 11 NHMRC project grants since 2006. He has authored more than 280 articles and book chapters in peer reviewed journals including the NEJM, Lancet, Eur Heart J, Circulation, Hypertension, J Am Soc Nephrol and others. He has received several research prizes and awards including the Australian Museum Eureka Prize for Medical Research Translation and the HBPRCA Colin I Johnston Lecturer Award.

He serves on the Executive Committee of the High Blood Pressure Research Council of Australia and is a member of the Council of the International Society of Hypertension and Chair of the Regional Advisory Group for Asia & Australasia. He is also a founding member of the ESH Working Group on Interventional Treatment of Hypertension. He is on the Editorial Board of Hypertension and Journal of Hypertension.

Since 2006 he is Head of the Neurovascular Hypertension and Kidney Disease Laboratory at the Baker Heart and Diabetes Research Institute, Melbourne, and currently holds an NHMRC Senior Research Fellowship. He has served on several guideline committees including the recent National Heart Foundation Hypertension Guidelines Committee. In July 2014 he has taken up the Dobney Chair in Clinical Research at the University of Western Australia and Royal Perth Hospital, where he provides comprehensive hypertension services as Head of the Dobney Hypertension Centre (DHC), which is accredited as a Hypertension Excellence Centre by the European Society of Hypertension. He continues to run his lab at the Baker Heart and Diabetes Institute as an honorary research fellow.

Professor Paul Whelton

Dr. Whelton is a medical school graduate (MB) of University College Cork (National University of Ireland), Ireland who took his postgraduate clinical training in medicine and nephrology at Johns Hopkins University. He earned a master's degree (MSc) in clinical epidemiology from University of London and a doctoral research degree (MD) in prevention research from University College Cork (National University of Ireland). He spent 26 years at Johns Hopkins University as a faculty member in medicine/nephrology and subsequently in epidemiology. Amongst many leadership roles, he directed the Johns Hopkins General Clinical Research Center (GCRC) and founded the Welch Center for Prevention, Epidemiology, and Clinical Research. Subsequently, he served as Tulane University Dean, School of Public Health and Tropical Medicine, Dean, School of Medicine, and Senior Vice President for Health Sciences. Later, he was President/CEO, Loyola University Health System and Medical Center before returning to Tulane as the Show Chwan Health System Endowed Chair in Global Public Health.

Dr. Whelton's research interests include blood pressure-related cardiovascular/renal disease epidemiology, prevention, clinical trials, policy, and global health. He has chaired many studies funded by the US National Institutes of Health (NIH), including the Trials of Hypertension Prevention (TOHP), Trial of Nonpharmacologic Interventions in the Elderly (TONE), Antihypertensive and Lipid Lowering Treatment to Prevent Heart Attack Trial (ALLHAT) and Systolic Blood Pressure Intervention Trial (SPRINT). He chaired the 2017 American College of Cardiology/American Heart Association Blood Pressure Guideline Writing Committee. A recipient of the honorary degree Doctor Honoris Causa, he was awarded the American Heart Association Population Research Prize in 2007, the American Heart Association Blood Pressure Council Excellence in Hypertension Research Award in 2018, the American Heart Association Distinguished Scientist Award in 2019, and the National Kidney Foundation David M. Hume Memorial Award in 2021. He has published more than 500 peer reviewed manuscripts and almost 100 books/chapters, supplements, or monographs

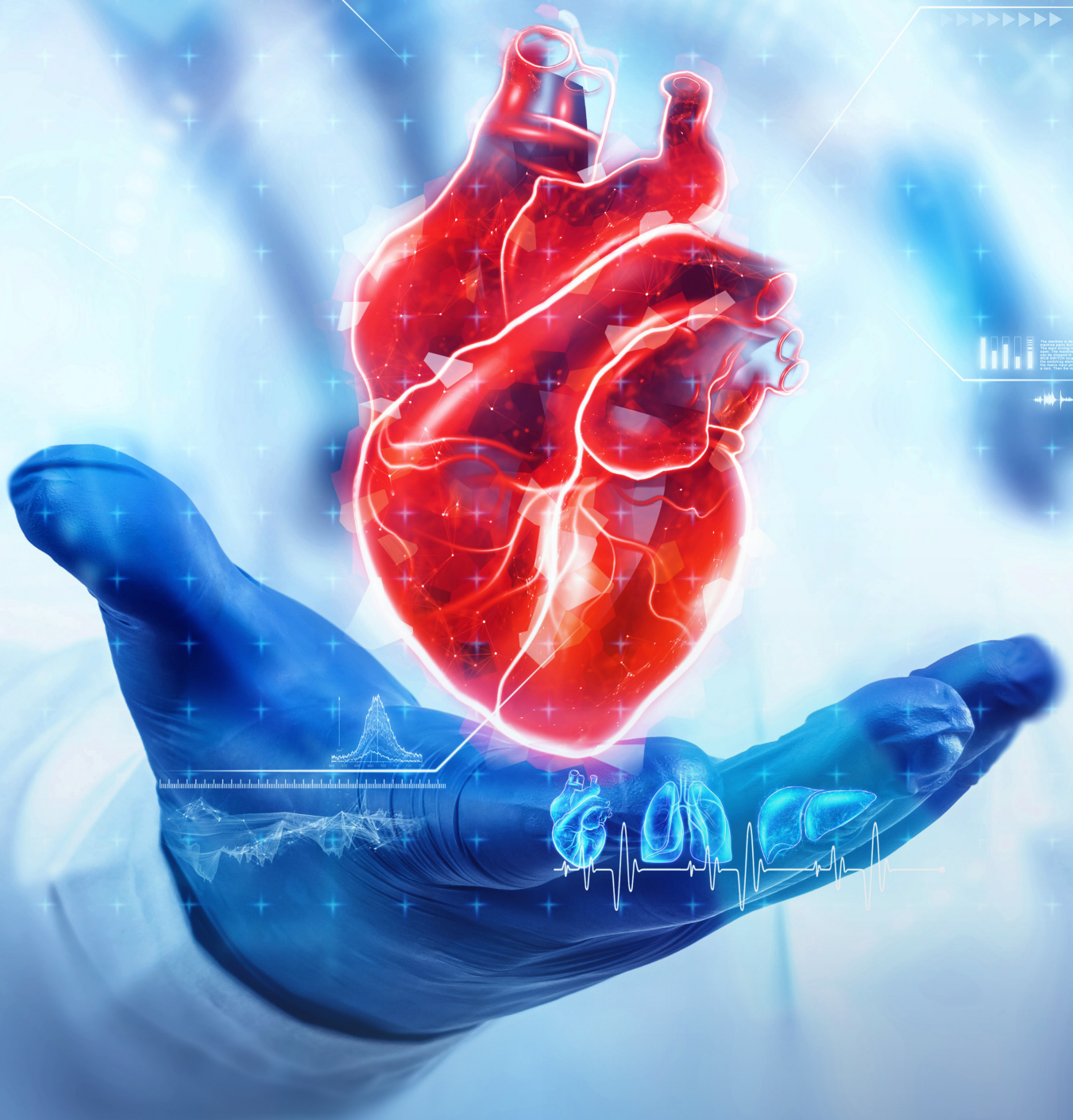
